

Personal Performance Awards Provider Requirements

Instructors, Coaches, Leaders, Raft Guides and Bell Boat Helms are able to deliver specific awards, providing greater access for the paddling community.

Full consideration has been given of how we support providers of the Personal Performance Awards and how access to training is made available. A specific [eLearning package](#) is available for **all** Providers to access, reducing the need to travel, enabling Providers to access the package in their own time, making this a more cost effective route for all Providers.

The eLearning package is centrally administered, maintained and monitored by British Canoeing Awarding Body. Once Providers have completed the eLearning, this will be corresponded with National Association Delivery Centres so records can be updated.

The eLearning will only be required to be completed once, even though Providers may be delivering multiple awards. The eLearning will cover the following topics:

- The award structures
- Philosophy of personal development and growth
- Standardisation of the awards
- Assessment principles and practices
- Administration processes

The eLearning is mandatory to enable Providers to deliver the Personal Performance Awards. On completion of the educational package, the Provider will be sent an electronic document of the eLearning for further reference, as well as a Personal Performance Awards Provider Logo, which they will be able to use in their promotion and marketing for running the awards.

The eLearning provides 10 points towards your CPD and will cost £15.

Delivery

The ethos behind the Personal Performance Awards is that these are very much paddler focused, empowering individuals in their own journey of development. The awards have been written in a way that moves from a prescriptive nature, allowing appropriate decision making to take place and skills that enable the paddler to manoeuvre their craft in that given environment.

Providers **must** remain current with National Association membership, a valid First Aid certificate, safeguarding training within the last 3 years and have up to date CPD.

Due to the nature of the awards, there is no need for registration or any time limits, allowing Providers to facilitate learning and recognise paddlers when they are at the appropriate standard with a British Canoeing Awarding Body Award.

Ratios for the awards are down to the Provider who should make the appropriate decisions depending on individuals, the group and the environment that they are operating. British Canoeing Awarding Body encourages you to remain familiar with the [Environmental Definitions and Deployment Guidance for Instructors, Coaches and Leaders](#).

There are no age restrictions for any of the awards, but Providers need to ensure the appropriate safeguarding mechanisms are in place.

There is no minimal delivery requirement, however all Providers will need to complete additional training/moderation every three years. This update will either be through a webinar or similar eLearning system, reducing travel and time commitments.

The Personal Performance Awards are not directly linked to British Canoeing Awarding Body Coaching and Leadership awards; however, they are ideal to provide appropriate milestones and acknowledgement of a paddler's personal skills, setting up the paddler appropriately and in a strong place for the Coaching and Leadership qualifications offered by British Canoeing Awarding Body.
